AFTER RECESS

The Senate met at 7:00 a.m. and was called to order by Senator Williams.

SESSION HELD FOR LOCAL AND UNCONTESTED CALENDAR

The Presiding Officer announced that the time had arrived to consider bills and resolutions placed on the Local and Uncontested Calendar. Notice of consideration of the local calendar was given by Senator Williams yesterday.

Pursuant to Senate Rule 9.03(d), the following bills and resolutions were laid before the Senate in the order listed, read second time, amended where applicable, passed to engrossment or third reading, read third time, and passed. The votes on passage to engrossment or third reading, suspension of the Constitutional Three-day Rule, and final passage are indicated after each caption. Senator Shapleigh offered the following committee amendment to the bill:

Committee Amendment No. 1

Amend SB 2178 (introduced version) as follows:

- (1) In SECTION 1 of the bill, in added Section 32.351, Education Code (page 1, line 11), strike "members of the local community" and substitute "students and their parents".
- (2) In SECTION 1 of the bill, in added Sections 32.353(2)(A), (B), and (C), Education Code (page 2, lines 4-7 and 11-12), strike "students, parents, and other area residents" each place it appears and substitute "students and parents".

The amendment to SB 2178 was read and was adopted by a viva voce vote.

All Members are deemed to have voted "Yea" on the adoption of Committee Amendment No. 1.

On motion of Senator Shapleigh and by unanimous consent, the caption was amended to conform to the body of the bill as amended.
